



NOAH'S STORY

Noah Brown is a smart, witty and charming teenager. He plays the violin and tennis in his free time. If you saw him today, you would never imagine that just last year Noah spent 2 weeks in a rehabilitation program with intense physical therapy and multiple stops to Akron Children's Hospital's Pain Center for what was determined to be a disc herniation due to growing pains. At 14 years old, Noah is almost 6 foot tall and for the past 2 years, he went up half a shoe size every 3 months. Noah was in so much pain during his immense growth spurt that he could barely walk and would occasionally black out.

Noah and his family are from Bellville, Ohio, about 70 miles outside of Akron. During his treatment at Akron Children's Hospital, Noah and his mom, Teresa and dad, Charles spent 8 days at the Ronald McDonald House of Akron so they would not have to make the painful and exhausting daily commute back home.

When asked what it was like to stay at the Ronald McDonald House and what it meant to his family, Noah responded, **"It became our home-away-from-home. It was a big blessing and meant that we did not have to have that stress of going home every day. It was very helpful."**

After his treatment was complete, Noah walked out of the House with a smile on his face and the promise to return to the House for visits. Not only does he continue to visit, he often brings in donations to help other families and on his last visit, he brought along his violin where he treated the staff to a special performance!

It's been almost a year since Noah and his family stayed at RMH of Akron. It was a year filled with struggles but also triumphs. Now that this is past him, Noah says he is feeling great and looking forward to playing Varsity tennis, camping, youth group activities and other normal fun activities with no more pain! He has also promised to continue visiting his 'friends' at his special home-away-from-home, Ronald McDonald House of Akron.
